This strategic development allows approved game studios, platform developers, payment processors, and related iGaming service providers to become formally recognized without duplicating existing licenses from reputable jurisdictions.

The Recognition Certificate is now a requirement for all B2B service providers who wish to partner with operators licensed in Anjouan.



Why It Matters

The Recognition Certificate is designed to enhance the integrity and security of the Anjouan-licensed ecosystem. By ensuring that only compliant, trustworthy, and regulated suppliers support licensed operators, Anjouan is aligning its framework with international best practices.

Who Is Eligible?

If you are a B2B service provider already licensed or regulated in a credible jurisdiction, you may apply for fast-track recognition. Eligible jurisdictions include:

- Malta
- Isle of Man
- Sweden
- Romania
- Other EU/EEA or established regulatory bodies

If your company is not yet licensed, you may instead apply for a full Anjouan B2B Gaming License, which provides the same access and recognition from within the jurisdiction itself.

Who Needs the Recognition Certificate?

All B2B providers working with Anjouan-licensed B2C operators must now either:

1. Hold a valid Anjouan B2B Provider License, or
2. Be officially recognized through the Recognition Certificate Program

This applies to:

- Casino and sportsbook game developers
- Live dealer and RNG providers
- Platform and white-label solution providers

For Recognition Certificate (if already licensed elsewhere):

Valid gaming license from a recognized jurisdiction

Corporate documents

KYC documents for directors and shareholders

Business summary outlining services and clients

For Full Anjouan B2B License (if unlicensed):

Incorporation in Anjouan (can be arranged via GamingLicense.com)

Business plan

Certified KYC and criminal background checks

Technical documentation (if applicable)

EUR 13,000

This fee includes initial review, onboarding, and issuance of the Recognition Certificate.

Annual Renewal:

EUR 13,000

The same amount applies for each subsequent year to maintain active recognition status under the Anjouan Gaming Board.
